

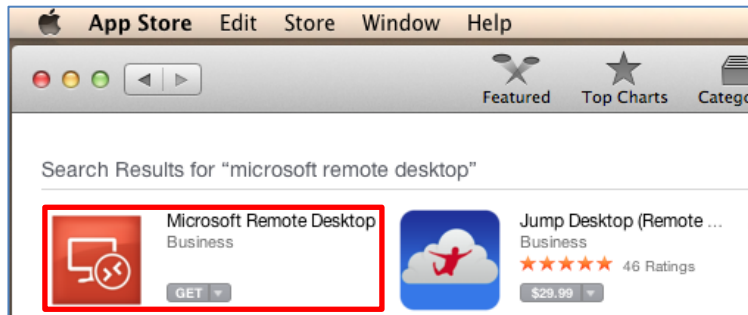
MyResearch – Mac Instructions for Installation

This job aid explains how to obtain the free Microsoft Remote Desktop application and install it on a Mac.

1. Access the App Store.



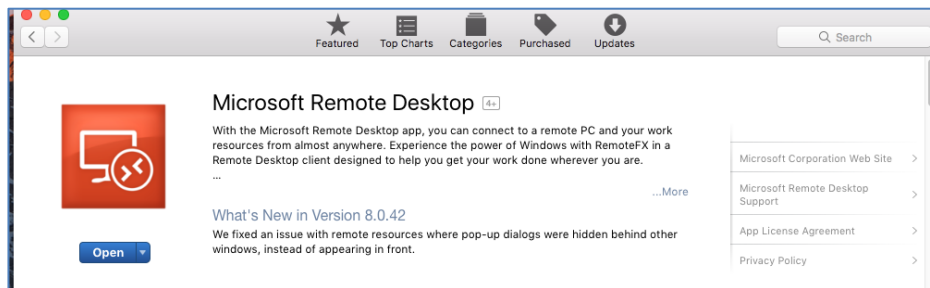
2. Click the 'Get' button under the Microsoft Remote Desktop heading.



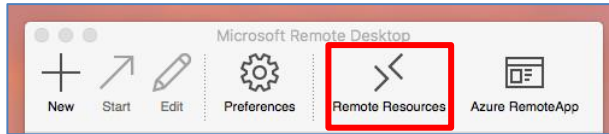
The INSTALL APP button displays.

4. Click “Remote Resources”.

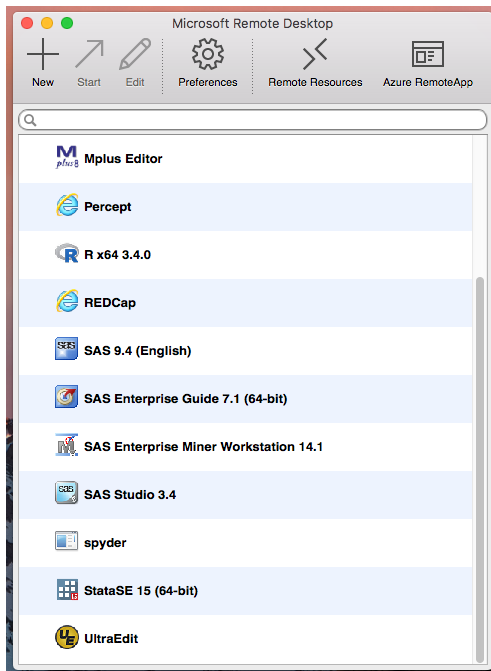


Type <https://arsportal.ucsf.edu/RDWeb/Feed/webfeed.aspx> in the URL field, complete the User name and Password fields and press Enter.
